For 20 years, GCDC has worked year-round with students in grades 5-12, including some of DC's most underserved communities, to build global and cultural awareness, improve public speaking, critical thinking, and writing skills, and expand students' views of local and international issues.

Every spring, GCDC holds its Model UN Conference, the culmination and exhibition of students' preparation throughout the school year. As a result of the conference, a strong majority of students each year report being more confident in their public speaking and negotiation skills, more knowledgeable in major global issues, and having a greater appreciation of their position as global citizens. The 20th AnnualSpring Model UN Conference is taking place at the United States Department of State on April 29, 2024.
