Call Your Representative Today

Find your <u>Representative</u> and <u>Senators'</u> office phone number. Phone numbers are also available on each state's page or on your senator's website. Say the following:

Hello, my name is [name], and I am a constituent from [your state, city, or town]. I am calling to let Representative/Senator [Congressperson's name] know that I support the right of all people to have safe and equitable access to abortion, regardless of their age, location, socioeconomic status, or circumstances in order to make the best choice for themselves. For that reason, I ask that [State Representative] support the bipartisan <u>Senate Bill 4688, Reproductive Freedom for All Act</u> or <u>House Bill</u> <u>3755 Women's Health Protection Act</u>. Thank you for your time.

The State of Abortion in the DMV

Abortions are currently legal in D.C., Maryland, and Virgina. Abortion access is most restricted and currently at risk in Virginia, while D.C. provides the most robust abortion care including late-stage and third trimester procedures, abortions for people younger than 18 without parent permission, and care for people residing outside the District. New bills such as the Enhancing Reproductive Health Protections Amendment Act of 2022 and the Human Rights Sanctuary Amendment Act of 2022 are being introduced in DC to provide further protections for those seeking abortions as well as those who assist in accessing reproductive healthcare. In Virginia, bills like HB 1274 and HB 304 have been introduced which would prohibit abortion after 20 weeks gestation and criminalize abortion providers.

Current Restrictions on Abortion¹:

D.C.

Public funding is available for abortion only in cases of life endangerment, rape or incest.

Maryland

- The parent of a minor must be notified before an abortion is provided; health professionals are allowed to waive parental involvement in limited circumstances.
- An abortion may be performed at or after viability only if the patient's life or health is endangered or there is a fetal anomaly.

Virginia

- Abortion is covered under insurance policies for public employees or available for public funding only in cases of life endangerment, rape, incest or fetal impairment, with a burden of proving need.
- The parent of a minor must consent and be notified before an abortion is provided.
- An abortion during the third trimester may be performed only if the patient's life or health is endangered.
